**THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (ROUNDAABOUT AT BROOM AVENUE, WITHERWIN AVENUE,
BRIDGE LANE AND LONGWOOD ROAD) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & CLEARWAY)**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that, in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice, the Council intends to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of driving & clearway as follows: **Broom Avenue** from its junction with Longwood Road/Bridge Lane to its junction with Lyon's Lane; **Witherwin Avenue** from its junction with Longwood Road/Bridge Lane to Dingle Brook; **Bridge Lane** from its junction with Broom Avenue/Witherwin Avenue to its junction with Epsom Gardens; **Longwood Road** from its junction with Broom Avenue/Witherwin Avenue to its junction with Harrow Close.

The Order will be effective from 9 October 2023 for 5 weeks, between 7pm and 1am, when signed on site. Access will be under the control of the relevant Contractor for the duration of the works. The alternative route will be via London Road, Longwood Road, Dipping Brook Avenue, Blackcap Road Stretton Road, Lumb Brook Road and vice versa or via Lumb Brook Road, Grappenhall Lane, London Road, Longwood Road and vice versa. The restrictions are required for carriageway resurfacing.
