THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (A49 LONDON ROAD, APPLETON)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING, CLEARWAY & SUSPENSION) TEMPORARY ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that, in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice, the Council intends to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of which will be as follows: -

Temporary Prohibition of Driving & Clearway: A49 London Road from its junction with Quarry Lane to its junction with Longwood Road.

Temporary Suspension of The Borough of Warrington (Quarry Lane) (One-Way) Order 2009 in its entirety.

The Order will be effective from 22nd April 2024 for 6 weeks, between 7pm and 1am, as and when signed on site. Access will be under the control of the relevant Contractor for the duration of the works. The alternative route will be via Lyon's Lane, Broom Avenue, Longwood Road and vice versa. The restrictions are required for carriageway resurfacing.
